This past year, we celebrated our 20th Anniversary! Reality Changers started in 2001 with just four students. Today, we have more than 3,000 graduates who live, work, and study all over the world.

Since 2001, we have not only expanded to serve more first-generation students but also adapted our programming to better meet their needs. For example, we created the Alumni Network to serve youth after high school, we established new partnerships to diversify our offerings, and we added professional development and career-readiness curricula to our programs.

We know that delivering high-quality, change-making programs requires flexibility, collaboration, and a can-do attitude; especially during an ongoing global pandemic.

Together, with the support of our community and the absolute determination of our students, volunteers, and staff, we were able to implement online programming for an entire school year. Last year, our youth toured colleges, worked with tutors, gave speeches, attended alumni reunions, and more–all virtually. While we know that distance learning is less than ideal, we are proud to have kept our virtual doors open and graduated 137 students during this time.

Reality Changers serves young people who will be the first in their families to graduate from college. Our diverse students are members of communities that are typically underrepresented on college campuses.


OUR WHY

ONLINE LEARNING

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Reality Changers programs remained mostly virtual for the 2020-2021 School Year.

Virtual programming was designed to be engaging, relevant, and gracious. Staff worked hard to stay abreast of industry best practices and education theory, while centering the needs and experiences of our youth. Weekly programs were broken into bite-sized, gamified lessons that focused on our key learning topics: college knowledge, academic readiness, and leadership development.

Together with our volunteers, we were able to facilitate 1-on-1 virtual tutoring sessions on a weekly basis, with additional support available as needed.

MEETING NEEDS

In addition to health concerns, the COVID-19 pandemic created new problems and exacerbated existing stressors for students and families.

Since March of 2020, Reality Changers has worked hard to help connect students and families with community resources like food pantries, mental health services, COVID testing and vaccination clinics, free school supplies, and more.

Reality Changers is proud to work together with students, families, volunteers, donors, organizations, and businesses to create change for youth and their communities.

CODING THE FUTURE

Together with San Diego Squared, Robolink, Softstack Factory, and The San Diego Foundation, Reality Changers provided more than 500 hours of computer coding training to students, including hands-on experience with Al and drones.

CONNECTING TO MORE THAN WIFI



After school, participants had the opportunity to try out music creation and production with industry professionals.


LEVELING UP















TOTAL POST-SECONDARY











TOTAL EXPENSES = \$1,765,155.86




^{*}Reality Changers is a direct-service organization. This means that all services are delivered, free of charge, to program participants by trained staff.
